1. Controller

2. Purposes

(1) Overview of your data - visualisation of your own measurements in web and app. (2) Sharing with doctors you select - only after explicit grant, revocable. (3) Research on new algorithms - prefer anonymised/aggregated data; personal health data for R&D only with Art. 9(2)(a) consent, withdrawable. (4) Account, authentication, platform operation. (5) Optional Dexcom/Withings and APNs/Live Activities.

3. Data categories

Account data (Keycloak), health/measurement data (Dexcom Share/OAuth EGVs, manual entries, Withings), doctor shares, device/push tokens (APNs), technical audit logs (hashed IPs).

4. Legal bases

Art. 6(1)(b) contract (account, overview). Art. 6(1)(a) / Art. 9(2)(a) consent (health data, integrations, doctor sharing, algorithm research with personal data, APNs). Art. 6(1)(f) legitimate interests (security, abuse prevention, anonymous metrics).

5. Recipients

EU hosting; Keycloak at auth.glucose.center; Dexcom and Withings when connected; Apple APNs for push/Live Activities; doctors you select. We do not sell health data.

6. Storage and security

Content encrypted at rest with AES-GCM (per-user AAD); TLS in transit. Retained while the account exists; personal content removed after deletion. Anonymised/aggregated research data may remain.

7. Rights

Access, rectification, erasure, restriction, portability, objection, withdraw consent. Export and account deletion in the product. Complaint to a supervisory authority.

8. Cookies

Technically necessary cookies/storage for login/session only. No third-party ad/tracking cookies.

9. Not a medical device

glucose.center is not a medical device and does not replace clinical advice, diagnosis, treatment, or an approved CGM. Algorithms/visualisations support overview and research, not clinical decisions.
